Tips for Kids

- Be sure a parent or safe adult is there to supervise you.
- Show your safe adult the places you like to visit online.
- Get permission from a safe adult before you share pictures or video.
- Don't tell strangers online your name, age, address or where you go to school unless a safe adult says it's okay.
- Tell a safe adult if you see weird pictures online or someone asks you to keep secrets.
